It can contribute, in particular, to improving working conditions and promoting social justice, as it makes it possible to strengthen social rights.

Referees, through the Portuguese Association of Football Referees

Recognising the importance of social dialogue, Liga Portugal aims to promote good working relations between all stakeholders, namely the various social partners, with the following objectives:

- Contributing to the development of proposals for measures to promote social dialogue;
- Striving for contractual stability between the social partners;
- Preparing and promoting the dissemination of relevant information on social dialogue and collective bargaining;
- Promoting debate on social dialogue and industrial relations through the Social Dialogue Commission;
- Raising awareness of the importance of social dialogue among employees and other stakeholders.
- Promoting communication platforms for all stakeholders, taking into account their contributions and expectations.
